#### Art 9

The prize will be officially awarded to the winner at the plenary session of the Congress 2010 on Thursday 7 October 2010.

The winner will be awarded access to the Congress with a "module", an equipped 6-sq.m space, worth €24 000 excluding VAT, as well as a workshop during which to present the product.
